## REGULATIONS

### ART. 1. Organizer

Organizer of the 13th Race of the Majal Hubala Walk is the Olympic Sports Club that organizes the race in accordance with UCI regulations.

XII Major Hubal Walk Race will take place from 1-4 June 2017

Co-organizers of the race are: Town and Commune Office Końskie, Commune Office Drzewica Town and Commune Office Busko-Zdrój, Town and Commune Office Kazimierza Wielka, Town and Commune Office Skarżysko-Kamienna, Commune Office Poświętne and Municipal Office Radoszyce, Marshal's Office of the Świętokrzyskie Voivodship .

### ART. 2. Type of race

The race can be participated in players under the elite category and under 23 years (born 1998 and older). The race is in the UCI Calendar and has the ME 2.1 class. Players will earn points for UCI classification in accordance with UCI Article 2.10.008.

### ART. 3. Participation

The XII International Cycling Race Route of Fights Mjr.Hubal open to UCI World Teams (up to 50%), UCI continental professional groups, UCI continental groups, national teams according to UCI Article 2.1.005. Number of players in the team: max.8, minimum 5. The start of the race is 31 May 2017 in the presentation of the team and start in the criterion " Marian Forma Cup" in Kielce. The criterion will not be included in the General Classification, so completing it is not compulsory.

### ART. 4. Race Office

The issue of the starting numbers will take place in the Race Office on 31 May in Kielce ul. Piotru Ściegiennego 8 on the grounds of the Korona Kielce stadium, from 13.00 to 16.30. The presentation of the teams and the "Marian Forma Cup" criterium at. 18.00 in Kielce, ul. Sienkiewicz. The technical briefing will be held in accordance with art. 1.2.087 UCI regulations on May 31 at the Race Office at 16.30

### ART. 5. Radio Tour

The Race Radio will work at 27.00 MHZ.

### ART. 6. Neutral technical support

The organizer provides 3 neutral vehicles equipped with standard equipment. There are no wheels fitted for disc brakes. If necessary, it is possible to transfer such wheels by the crew to a neutral vehicle.

### ART. 7. Accidents in the last 3 km before the finish

During the race, articles 2.6.027 and 2.6.029 of the UCL will apply to incidents in the last 3 kilometers to the finish of the joint start.

### ART. 8. Individual general classification - yellow jersey,

Individual classification will be conducted in accordance with UCI Art. 2.6.015.

### ART. 9. Point classification - red shirt in white peas.

Points classification will be conducted in accordance with UCI Art. 2.6.017.

The first 20 players at the finish of each of the stages from the start will receive the following points:

- 20; 19; 18; 17; 16; 15; 14; 13; 12; 11; 10; 9; 8; 7; 6; 5; 4; 3; 2; 1.

The top 3 finishers will receive the following points:

- 3; 2; 1.

### **ART. 10. Mountain classification - green jersey,**

Mountain classification will be conducted in accordance with UCI Art. 2.6.017.

Depending on the mountain bonus category, players will earn the following points:

I category - , 7, 4, 3, 2, 1, II category - , 3, 2, 1, III category - , 2;1

### **ART. 11. Junior classification U-23 - white shirt,**

Junior classification for players born in 1995-1998 on the basis of individual general classification.

### **ART. 12. Team classification**

Team classification will be conducted in accordance with UCI Art. 2.6.016.

### **ART. 13. Order of T-shirts**

If you run in several classifications. The order of T-shirts is in accordance with art. 8-11. And in the jersey the next competitor will be in the classification.

In the first stage the shirts will go:

- leader's jersey - winner of the "About the Marian Forms Cup"

- T-shirt Point - a player who will take first place at the finish of the last lap. The "About Marian Forma Cup"

- T-shirt Climber - a player who will take second place at the finish of the last lap. Criterion "About the Marian Forma Cup".

The top jersey of the U-23 category will be the youth jersey in the "About Marian Forma Cup" Criterion.

ART. 14. The stage of individual driving on time

The second stage will be played as an individual ride on time. Athletes take turns in reverse order to the places they occupy after Stage One, every 1 minute, and players occupying 1-10 every 2 minutes.

Prior to the start of the race, competitors are required to report in advance for inspection of the bicycle.

### **ART. 15. Bonifications**

Bonuses will be awarded in accordance with Article 2.6.019 of the UCI Rules:

- on the flying finals - 3, 2, 1 seconds for the first three players

- At the finish of the half-stage III - 6, 4, 2 seconds for the first three players

- in the stages of the joint start - 10, 6, 4 seconds for the first three players

### **ART. 16. Timeout**

Time limit is 10% but maximum of 5 minutes. This limit applies throughout the distance.

The time limit for the 2nd stage individual time is 20%.

The time limit may be changed by the Jury Commission in consultation with the organizer in accordance with Article 2.6.032 of the UCI Rules.

### **ART. 17. Anti-Doping Control**

The anti-doping control will be conducted in accordance with UCI regulations as well as in accordance with Polish law and Polish anti-doping regulations.

ART. 18. Official ceremonies

According to Art. 1.2.113 UCI rules players should appear for the decoration in the racing uniform within 10 minutes of arrival on the finish line. After each stage, the top three players on the stage and the leaders of the individual general, point, mountain and youth classification will be notified.

For 15 min. Before the start of each stage of the joint start will be the presentation of classification leaders.

### **ART. 17. Penalties**

Punishments according to UCI regulations.

### **ART. L8. Security matters**

The race is torn in limited traffic - the transverse and the opposite traffic is closed for the lead and peloton passage. Athletes outside of the lead or peloton are obliged to take the right side of the road. Race participants must include all own and vehicle insurance on their own. Competitors and competitors are required to comply with the rules and regulations of the road traffic. Athletes and all other participants of the race enjoy the right not to comply with traffic regulations only at crossroads supervised by police officers using a car and in cases where a police vehicle is directly in front of them or ahead of the race. In all other cases, both drivers and other vehicle drivers are subject to traffic regulations.
